Congratulations to all for completing another school year!

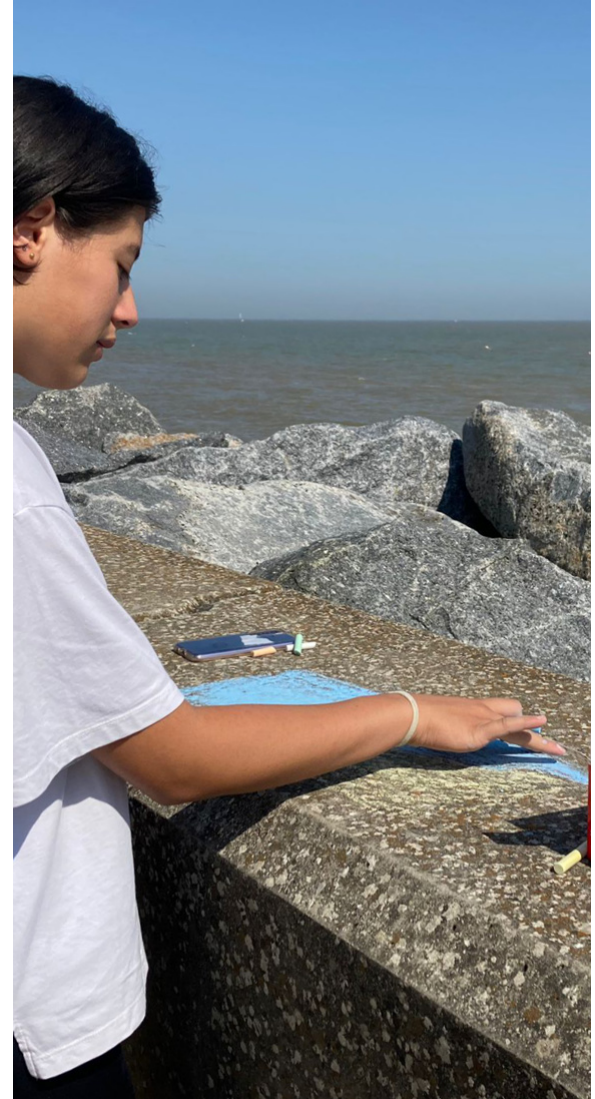

Our exam year students worked hard during the exam period, we are all very proud of their successes and achievements.

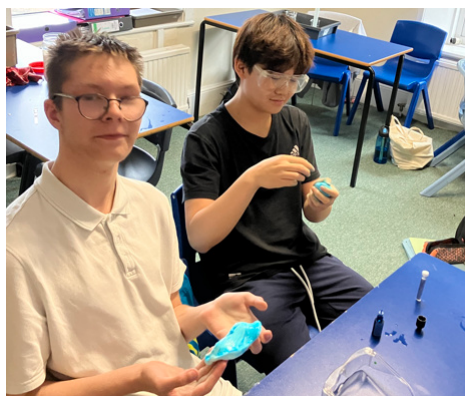

Careers News

Students in KS3 have looked at good health and wellbeing, and how this is important in the workplace. The students also considered diversity, equality and stereotyping in the workplace, which stimulated some excellent discussion. Students learnt about careers in conservation during a visit to the Owl Sanctuary (*see photos on the next page*), as well as being given flying demonstrations and hearing a talk about animal behaviour.

KS4 students have looked at a variety of different career areas, such as Cyber Security and Transport and Logistics, including an online careers fair.

In year 12, students also started the term by looking at how to balance work and life, and the importance of looking after health and wellbeing in the workplace. We then discussed how to choose a university, how to apply to Oxbridge, and how to write a personal statement. Year 12 students were also given the opportunity to do some voluntary work at a local charity shop.

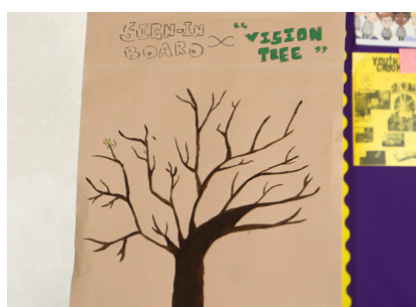
Summer Fair

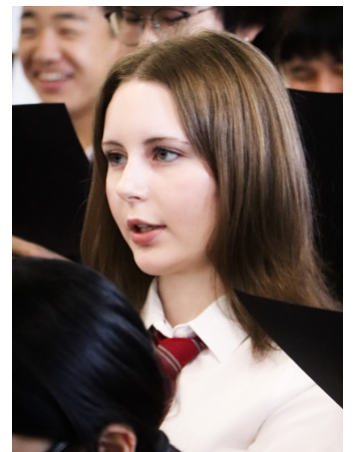
Summer School

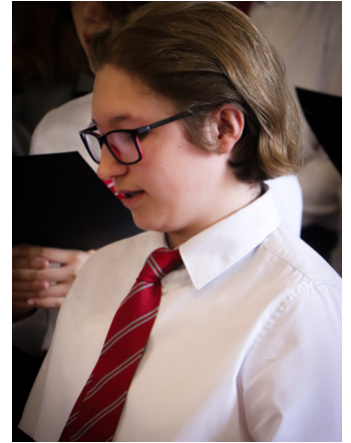

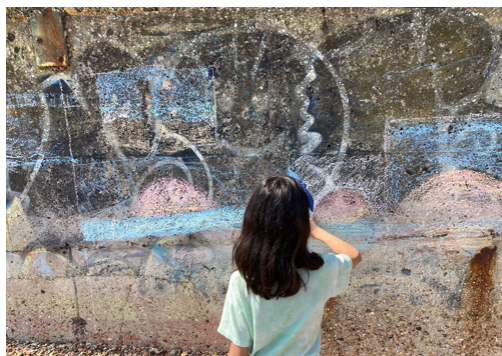
